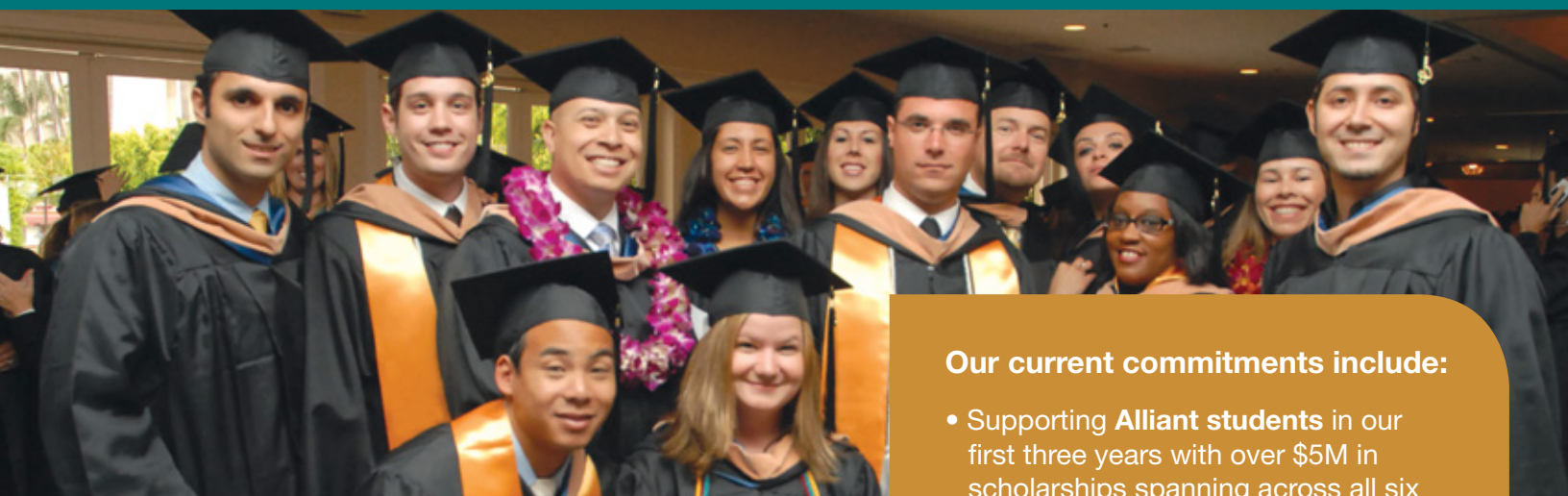
Is helping shape the future of those giving back to our local communities
